
Extended Care

Childcare from 8:00-9:00a.m. is available for children two years, six months and older. Acceptance of 2 ½ year olds into the A.M. Extended Care Program is dependent on the child's maturity and requires the approval of the school.

Noontime Extended Care is available for the children in the 2's classes who are 3 years old and potty trained. The cost is broken down per month.

Tuesday/Thursday AM \$35.00

Monday/ Wednesday/Friday AM \$50.00

Drop-ins will cost \$6.00 and will depend on availability.

Scholarships

Partial scholarships are available for some children who would otherwise be unable to attend the school. Scholarship applications are available from the director. These forms should be completed and returned to the school with your application form. The cost of the scholarship program is not included in regular tuition and parents may be asked to participate in fundraising projects to support this valuable program.

Two Year Old Program

Our program is specifically designed to meet the needs of the two to three year old child and is flexible to adapt to their changing needs. Our goals are to provide each child with the opportunity to develop physically, socially, emotionally and intellectually through play. Each morning is planned with age appropriate activities to meet these goals. We provide these activities in a warm, caring atmosphere in which each child is allowed to develop at his or her own pace.

Arrival: After parents sign their children in, the children are free to explore and interact in the various areas of the room. Sharing and taking turns are encouraged with the need for private space and parallel play respected.

Midmorning: Before snack, the children go outside where they may engage in sand play, climbing, jumping and riding on age appropriate toys (to name a few favored activities). After washing their hands, the children gather around the snack table for group singing, finger plays and conversation. Snack is served while conversation and other social skills continue to be encouraged.

Late morning: After snack, the children are free to engage in the day's project (art, crafts and science) or another activity of their choice. Following project time, the children help clean up the room before visiting the "Big" room. This is our indoor playroom for "large motor activities." After the Big room, the children rest on small mats brought from home. Parents are invited to join us at the end of the morning for songs, creative movement, finger plays, nursery rhymes and stories.

Registration

Incoming students must be 2 years old by September 1, 2011. Application forms are available in the classrooms, the church office, or by contacting the Director. Children of Congregational Church families and returning families have priority registration from Monday, February 28th to Friday, March 4th, 2011.

Applications for new students will be accepted from March 7th through the 11th. A lottery will be held to determine enrollment on March 14th. Families will be notified of the outcome on that date via e-mail or telephone. Applications are to be returned to the school with a \$50.00 non-refundable fee. Applications accepted after March 11th at 10AM will be placed according to availability.

Class Placement

A letter confirming a place for your child in Congregational Preschool will be mailed in May. In order to hold your child's place, the September tuition will be due by June 1, 2011. This check, made payable to Congregational Preschool, should be mailed to the school in care of the director. It is non-refundable unless you move from the Eugene area.

Immunization Forms and Insurance

Immunization forms and Child Enrollment forms are required for children to attend the preschool. These forms will be provided to you at Fall Orientation and must be completed and returned to the school before the child may attend class.

There is also a group insurance fee of \$10 for each child. This non-deductible policy covers the child to, from and during school. Information is available at the Fall Orientation Meeting in September and the fee is paid at that time.
