Additional Childcare for 4 year olds is available from 8:00 to 9:00a.m. and 12:00 to 1:00p.m. Children staying at noon bring their own lunches. The cost is broken down per month.

Scholarships

Partial scholarships are available for some children who would otherwise be unable to attend the school. Scholarship applications are available from teachers or the director. These forms should be completed and returned to the school with your application form. The cost of the scholarship program is not included in regular tuition and parents may be asked to participate in fund-raising projects to support this valuable program.

Four Year Old Program

Our Four-year-old program is designed to help children develop their social, intellectual, physical and emotional skills in a warm atmosphere of caring and humor. We encourage children to seek new experiences, to face problems and attempt to solve them, to exhibit a strong desire to learn, and to express their thoughts and feelings.

In the classrooms, the children can expect to find activities to encourage pre-reading and writing skills, cooking, science, math, music, drama and social interaction. Parents can expect a program with flexibility to meet the changing needs and interests of their children.

A wide variety of materials and learning centers are available throughout the morning. Children choose from independent and teacher-directed activities. Although there is flexibility within the daily schedule, a general routine is followed that provides the children with a sense of consistency and security.

Parents take turns providing nutritious snacks and children enjoy helping with its preparation and serving.

Special features may include guest speakers, pets, or planning a party for parents. The emphasis throughout the year will be in providing a rich variety of experiences to encourage exploration, self-direction and problem solving.

Registration

Incoming students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2011. Application forms are available in the classrooms, the church office, or by contacting the Director. Children of Congregational Church families and returning families have priority registration from Monday, February 28th to Friday, March 4th, 2011. Applications for new students will be accepted from March 7-11. A lottery will be held to determine enrollment on March 14th. Families will be notified of the outcome on that date via e-mail or telephone. Applications are to be returned to the school with a \$50.00 non-refundable fee. Applications accepted after March 11th will be placed according to availability.

Class Placement

A letter confirming a place for your child in Congregational Preschool will be mailed in May. In order to hold your child's place, the September tuition will be due by June 1, 2011. This check, made payable to Congregational Preschool, should be mailed to the school in care of the director. It is non-refundable unless you move from the Eugene area.

Immunization Forms and Insurance

Immunization forms and Child Care Enrollment forms are required for children to attend the preschool. These forms will be provided at Fall Orientation and must be completed and returned to the school before the child may attend class.

There is a group insurance fee of \$10 for each child. This non-deductible policy covers the child to, from and during school. Information is available at the Fall Orientation Meeting in September and the fee is paid at that time.
